






Management

- Small PAs "custodians" organizations without special staff designated only for the management of the PA







History Piatra Craiului

- 1842 the first cartographic studies Vienna Cartographic Institute
- 1863 geological study B. Hauer
- French geographer Emannuel de Martonne 1907 "a major accident in the morphology of the Southern Carpathians"
- 1938 Nature Reserve on 440 ha "the beauty of the landscape and the presence of rare species of flora"
- 1990 National Park
- 1998 first park administration
- 2001 Eurosite Management Award
- 2005 European Diploma for PAs

- -350 species of fungi (4 new for science)
- -220 species of likens
- -228 species of mosses
- -1108 species of vascular plants = 1/3 Romania
- -150 on the Romanian red list
- -53 endemic species

-2 species endemic to PC

Council of Europe European Diploma for PAs, since 2006

 ...awarded for adequately protected natural or semi-natural areas of exceptional European interest from the point of view of conservation of biological, geological or landscape diversity. It is awarded to them by virtue of their scientific, cultural or aesthetic interest if they have an appropriate protection system...
