- Specific data collections and management measures

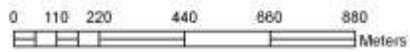
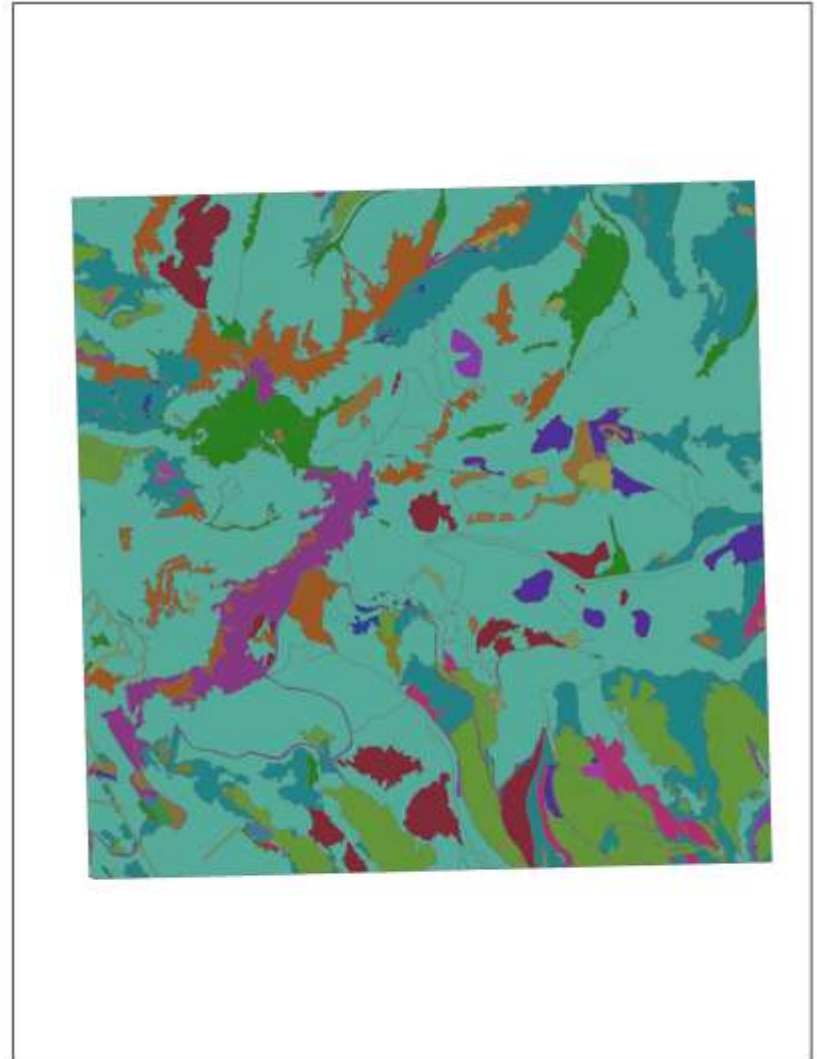
DINPD main interest

Our problems

- 1.) the lack of basic nature state data about DINP
– no state assessment, but continuous conflict
with forestry
- 2.) methodological problems: classical habitat
mapping data is not structural enough, new
multipurpose forest state assessment is needed
- 3.) lack of optimalization of the use of remote
sensing data

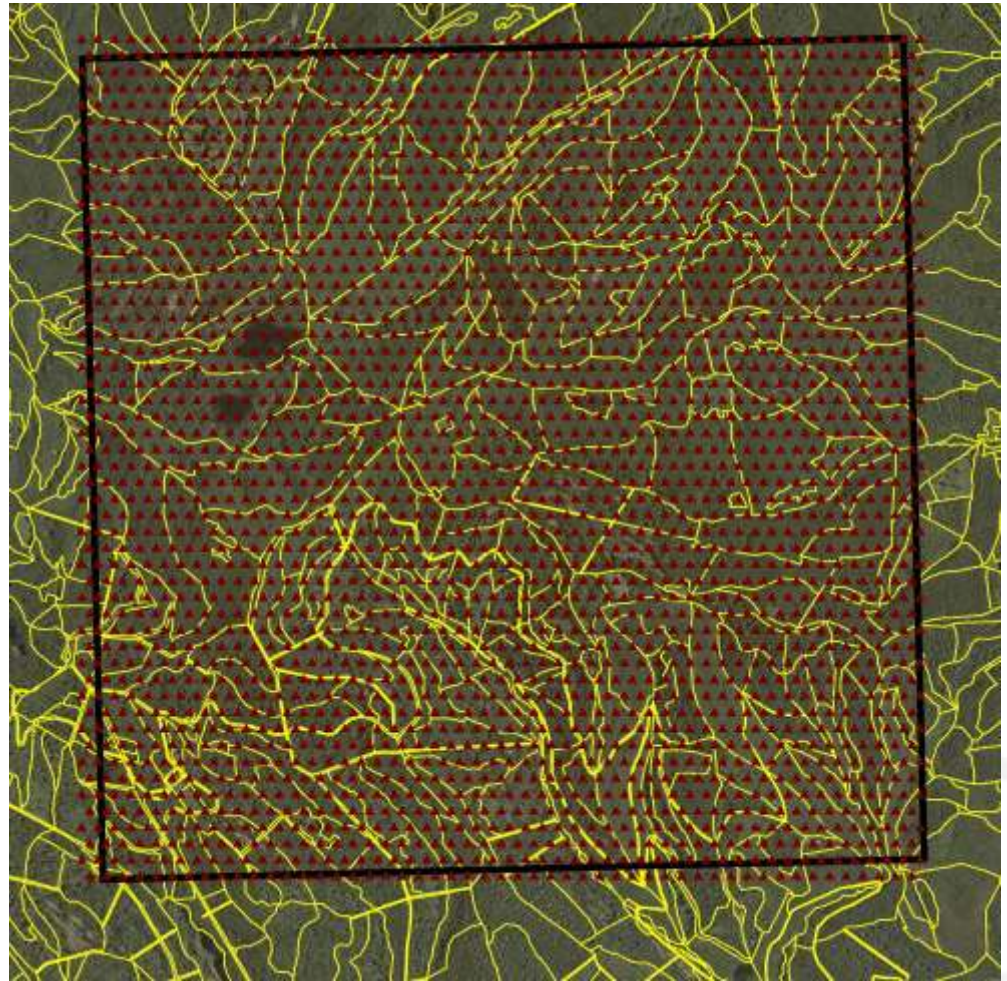
